**MOTLEY SPEAKS OUT ON SQUANDERING OF  
HIV/AIDS DOLLARS IN THE DISTRICT**

**Washington, DC (October 20, 2009)** -- In response to the recent investigative report by the *Washington Post* on the questionable expenditures associated with the funds granted to community groups by the Department of Health, Office of HIV/AIDS, Anthony "Tony" Motley, Candidate for an At-Large seat on the District of Columbia City Council in 2010 says, "This is totally unacceptable."

He adds, "With the high rate of HIV/AIDS in the District of Columbia there should be no instance of funds being squandered. The City Council Health Committee should have been more vigilant regarding this matter and should have provided constructive oversight and accountability of the spending.
